1.4	A photocopy of the return confirmed travel ticket.		
<b>2</b>	<b>Proof of Adequate Finance (At Least One)</b>		
2.1	Receipt of currency exchange of USD 700/ 20,000 Thai Baht per person OR USD 1400/ 40,000 Thai Baht per family		
2.2	A photocopy of the valid international credit card with applicant's name visible.		
2.3	Bank statement of six months with current balance of USD 700 per person.		
<b>3</b>	<b>Accommodation</b>		
3.1	Proof Of Hotel / accommodation reservation in Thailand with contact number and address		
<b>4</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS</b>		
4.1	<b>Film:</b> Original letter of permission-to-film from Thai Film Office and Office of Tourism Development.		
4.2	<b>Film:</b> Crew List attached with every application.		
4.3	<b>Press:</b> Permission from Press Division, Department of Information, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand.(In Case of Media/Journalist coverage)		

**Please Note**

**Validity of the visa** denotes the time period during which the traveller can use the visa.

**Period of stay** denotes the amount of time the traveller can stay in Thailand
